- His power point videos of both lecture and lab material need to be updated. He still has videos from 2018. In the videos there are questions being asked but you CAN'T hear them. He has "favorite" students. He spends more time in each video joking with past students, than he does talking about the material. The instructor has a set schedule for the material to be talked about over the course of the semester, however there was a part of a unit that he FAILED to go over because he would rather not move the test date. We were left to go over the material ourselves with questions that we might have.

- Don't have a set course schedule if you're not going to go over ALL THE MATERIAL!! There is absolutely no reason to have over 500 terms! No one is going to remember them. Tests need to have a consistant number of questions. Don't have a unit that has 150 terms and then on the test, question students over 5 terms.
