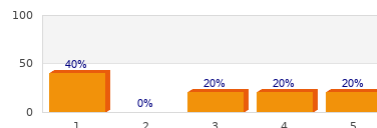

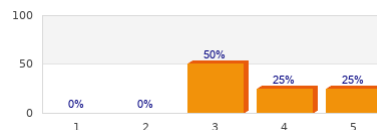

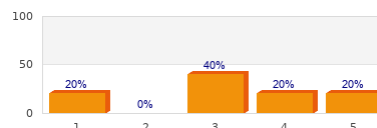

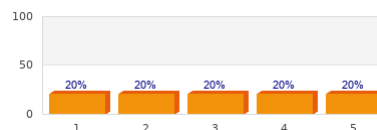

Very Unlikely

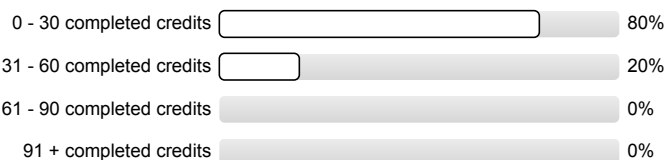

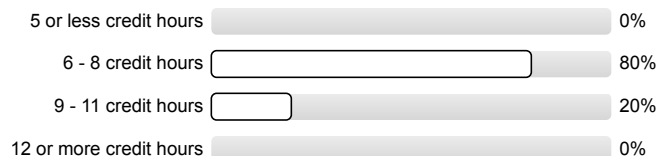

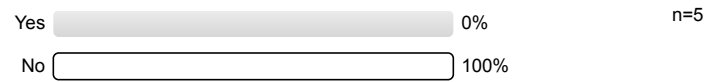
