- Material was presented in a way that I feel like did not encourage or motivate students for exams. Not much preparation and study guides were very vague. PowerPoint's for exams were upwards of 400 slides worth of information and lecture videos were just her reading the information through the slides with almost no commentary. I hope she condenses the information in a presentable way for students because a lot of information seemed as though it was just copied and pasted from excerpts of the book. PowerPoint's also had some errors that she would address in lecture videos but only after she realized she was confused herself about the information. On behalf of the 25 students enrolled in her course, we hope she can do better for the next group of students taking this course as a prerequisite for nursing programs.
