- 62) What changes would you recommend that would improve this course?
- I recommend not making major assignments due on a Friday, especially ones that don't require peer review. I am in a dual credit class taken at the high school, where almost all students are involved in extracurricular activities, many of which take place on Fridays and have multiple practices throughout the week. While I understand that we get assignments ahead of time, I find it hard to get started on them early before instruction in class. Being due on a Sunday would help a lot of kids to turn high-quality work in and have a little less anxiety about homework.
