





4.1) My instructor remains in the lab throughout my scheduled lab class







I would also recommend extending the duration of time from when you open/explain the assignment to when the assignment is due for class. Most of my assignments felt very rushed as the turnaround day was only one class day and the deadline was at 11 pm the night before class.

Also, providing the fact that you incorporate plays as a grade is cool, however, the execution of what you are wanting can be difficult as there sometimes seems to be a bias in/around religion.
