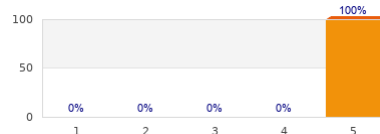

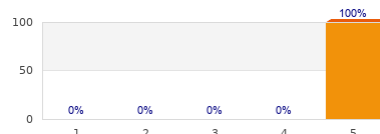

Very Dissatisfied



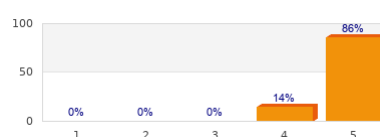

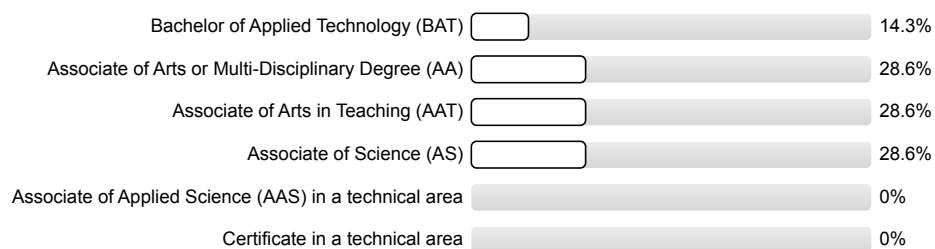
