



- The professor was very professional and answered emails in a timely manner.

- 6.2) What changes would you recommend that would improve this course?
- Finding more ways to teach the material, so we could learn and study it better.
- Have the class be in person
- Making the entire course available at the start of the semester giving students a chance to work ahead and start assignments early. If not, being consistent with the day that material is uploaded for that week and uploading all relevant material that day. Not releasing half of what you need on Sunday and posting lecture on Wednesday. Turn around time for releasing grades should be improved. Typically, all grades for the previous week are posted the beginning of the following week. We went through 9 assignments and took our first exam without receiving grades or feedback for any of those assignments prior to exam. After the first exam grades were still inconsistent, sometimes posted every week, sometimes every 2 weeks, etc. With this being a fully online course, instructor should expand "office hours" to allow for availability and responses more than 1 hour out of the day, 2 hours on only Tuesdays and Thursdays, to answer student questions.
- My suggestions for this course is discussing up front that even though the course is offered online, there will be times the work has to be performed out in the field. Some students take online courses for a reason, and being enrolled in an online course I expected to be able to do all of the work remotely.
