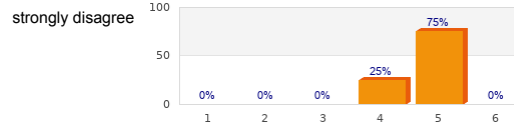

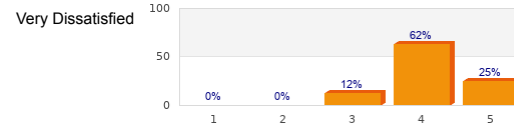

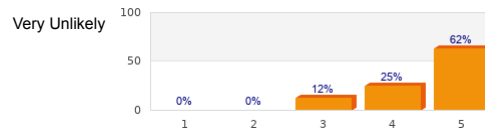

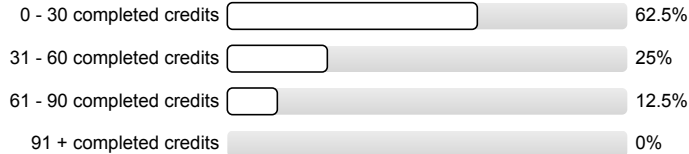


Very Likely

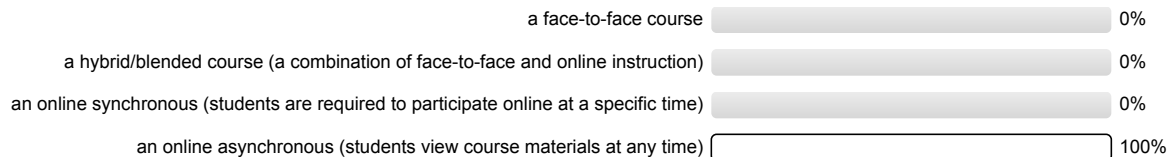

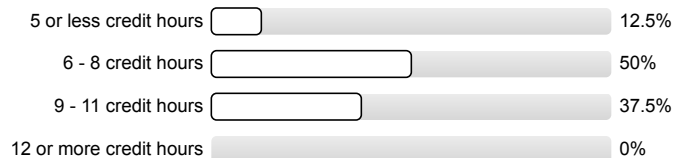

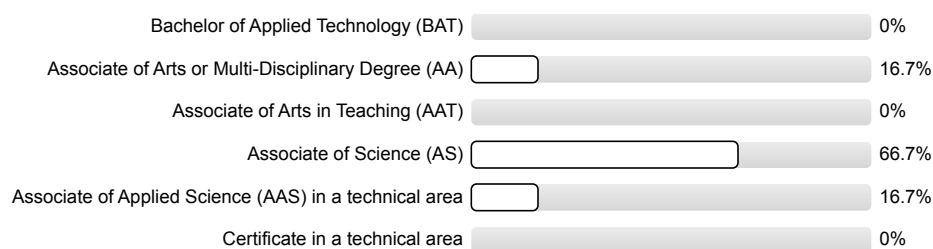
