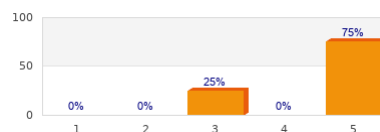

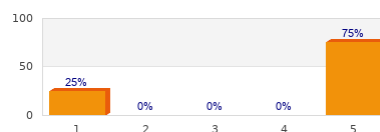

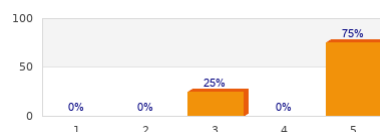

We're reading sections introducing beginning to cloud computing with basic information and then the lab expects me to setup servers via the command prompt like I've navigated that before.
