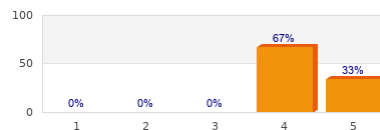

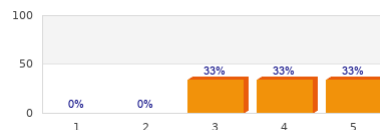

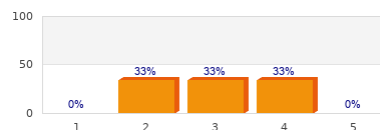

Very Dissatisfied



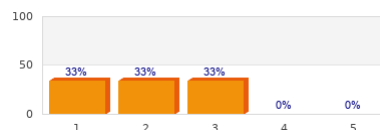

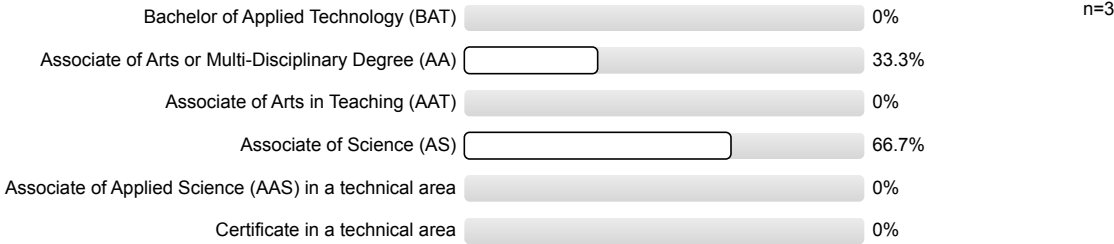
