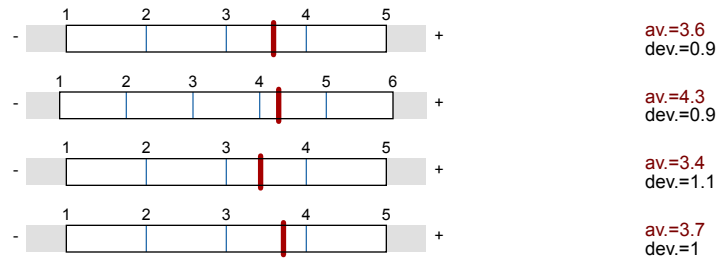

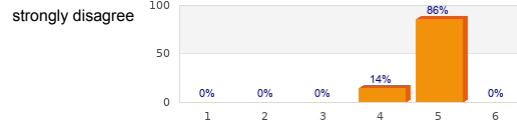

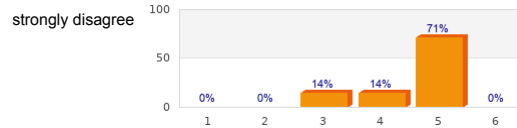

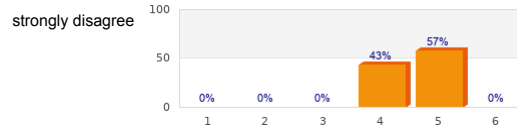

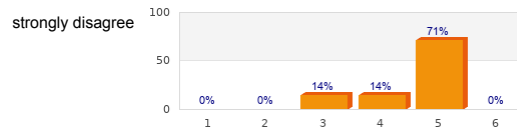

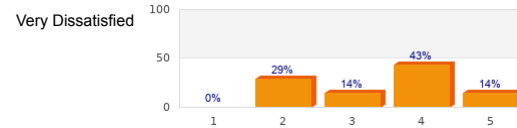

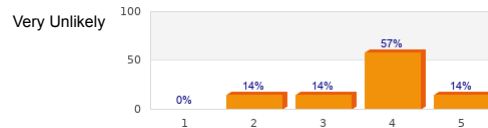

5.1) How likely are you to recommend this course with this instructor to a friend?

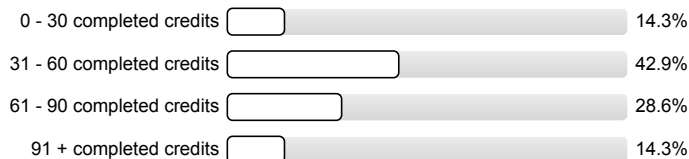

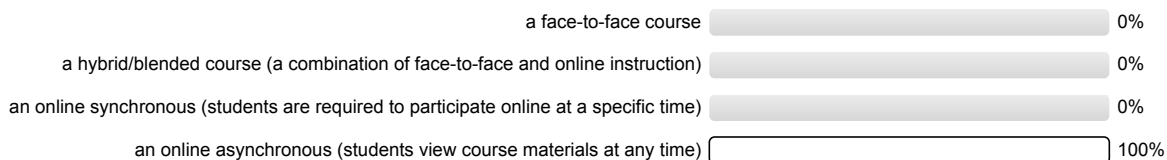

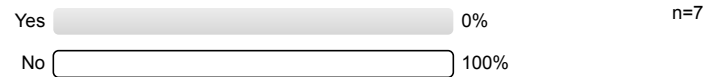
