- I would go into more detail in explaining the IRAC. Felt as if it were just thrown at us with no background or explaining.
- The course load is a little much for an 8 week class, especially considering other courses have similar intensive workloads that involve coordinating with groups with varying schedules.
- The discussions were related in theme with the chapters in the book but were not helpful in learning about ethics. In my opinion, They only taught us how to try and interpret supreme court cases that related to business laws but it is very difficult when you have no legal background at all. None of the discussions required knowledge from the course or textbook to answer. It was all googling information on cases so I'm not sure I learned anything new about ethics. The course also focused all directions on a healthcare management perspective which isn't the program I am in and I'm not in that field so its not very helpful.
 The final podcast deliverable didn't seem to actually tie into any of the class lessons at all. Nothing in the weekly assignments activities led us or helped us build the skills needed to complete the final deliverable it was very much just a crap shoot if your team figured something out again googling a topic for information.
