



9. Final Comment

- 9.1) The comment box provides a chance to anonymously communicate any specific impressions (either overall impressions or impressions about particular and specific things) to the instructor. Please feel free to write a lot in the comment box since your feedback is probably the single most important way that courses get better from one semester to the next.
- This course may be beneficial to a new college student, but for some that are taking it towards the end of their educational journey, the information can feel redundant. The instructor is clearly enthusiastic about the subject which brings vibrancy to online lectures. The grading can feel a bit "nit-picky", with point deductions over seemingly minor details, especially when all guidelines and requirements are followed. On one occasion I received a 10 point deduction for printing an assignment (that was a PDF file within the content), writing the answers and scanning them into a document. I received a 15 point deduction for a small mistake in formatting on one of the very first assignments. I lost 10 points for "not being concise enough", with no explanation or example, and on a writing that met all of the grading criteria. On another occasion I received a 5 point deduction, on an answer from a reading with no context on the error. It may not seem like a big issue to some, but this is incredibly frustrating for someone who is looking to transfer and is working to improve their GPA. Sometimes clear feedback was not issued regarding the point deductions, which offered no opportunity for growth or improvement.
