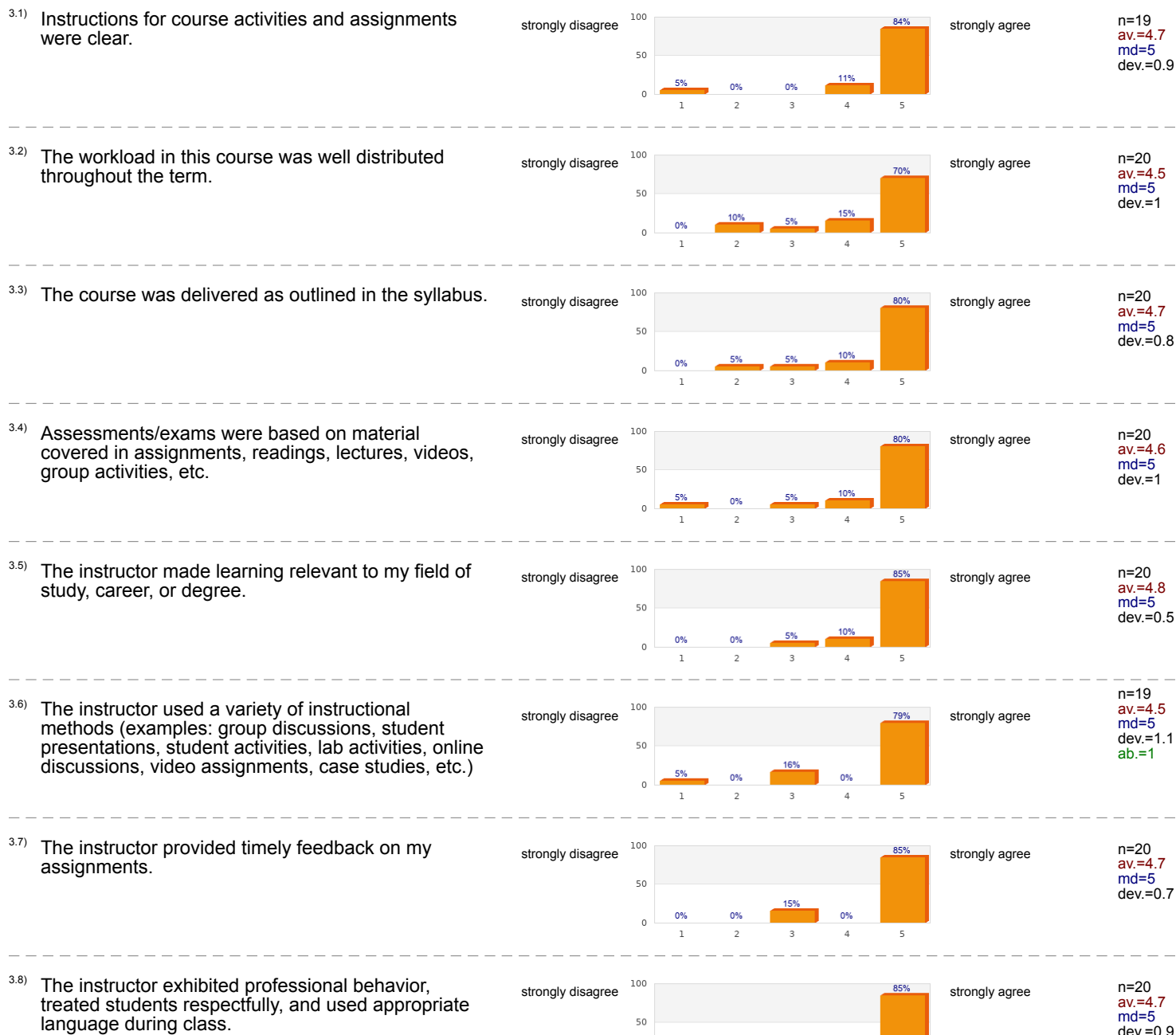

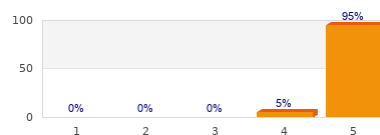

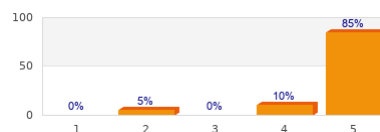

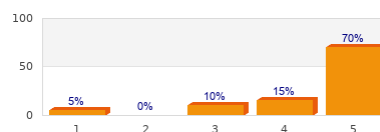

Very Dissatisfied



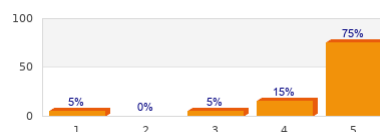

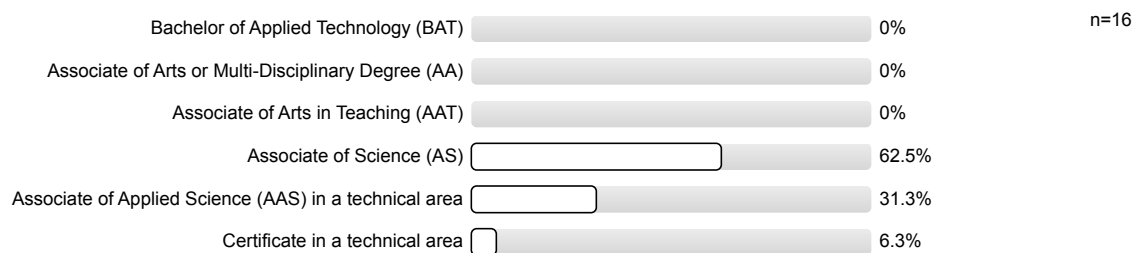
