On the other hand, the applications are the most useful on my opinion, most of all because the template let clear what is the assignment about. Concept work need to be better explained, It goes for the concept you get what it is suppose to be done and it is not. Another great aspect about it is allowing and incentivizing use of chat gpt which can be a great learning tool while making assignments easier to understand. The videos are also very good on explanation, intonation, amount of content and content (as important and useful content)
