6. Open Response:

- ^{6.1)} What are the strengths of this course?
- I found this course to be interesting and liked how it related to my daily activities in my current position. I felt challenged by this course and learned some great tips that I will utilize in the future.
- Rich content, fostered engagement in virtual setting. I cannot overstate the appreciation I have for Dr. Cooper-Sweat's acceptance of late assignment submissions for partial credit. I was more motivated to complete the work knowing that I could still receive credit for it.
- ^{6.2)} What changes would you recommend that would improve this course?
- The only thing I would recommend is that I felt that there were too many assignments for the week and it was a little difficult to handle while working full-time and taking another course. I did well on my assignments but it was a bit overwhelming.
- There is a part of me that wants to argue that the PowerPoint presentation adversely impacted adequate preparation for the final exam comprised of 20 essay questions. Although I deeply valued the exercise, it was mentally disharmonious to shift from a narrow focus (targeted presentation topic) to a broad focus. Perhaps, being tasked to create a presentation on multiple concepts from various chapters would have better prepared me for the final exam.
- ^{6.3)} Any further, constructive comments?
- If students are taking this course and do not have a lot of personal time, they may want to try taking this course by itself. You need to have great time management and be disciplined to do your assignments a little everyday for this course rather than waiting until the last day of the deadline.
- The weekly quizzes were multiple choice question format, and the weekly discussions contained specific, targeted concepts. I was a bit jarred by the format of the final exam asking broad topic essay-style questions. I suppose my suggestion would be to either implement multiple choice questions into the final exam, or implement essay-style questions into the weekly quizzes for a more congruent educational experience.
