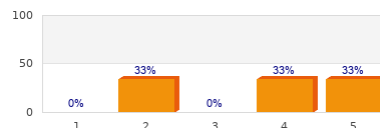

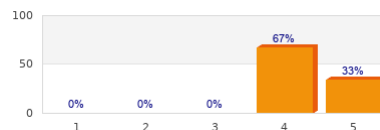

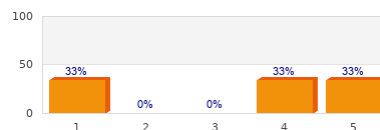

Very Dissatisfied



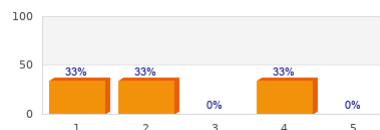

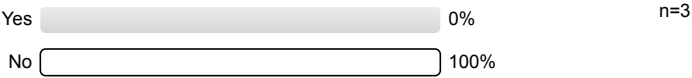

6.2) What changes would you recommend that would improve this course?

- A little less course work or group meetings required. Discussions were long and response length requirement was longer than all other classes I have ever taken.
- More flexibility with due dates for the assignments. When Brazosport College began offering online classes one of the main benefits was the flexibility of completing course material in a way that fits their schedule within the framework of having everything in by the end of the week. A lot of us in these courses are not just full time students. We are parents and full time working professionals who are going back to school to help further our careers. That is what was attractive about the online courses, they offered a better work/school/life balance. Recently there has seemed to be a shift in that balance. This course entails a high volume of work with specific due dates that force students to actively engage in the class 5+ days a week not counting the additional work that is required outside of class (team projects, case study's, chapter assignments, etc.). The improvement would be getting back the origins of online course and structuring courses in a way that fits the students work/school/life balance.
