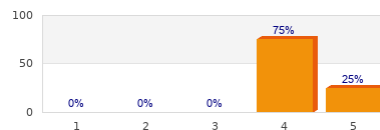

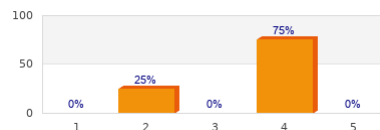

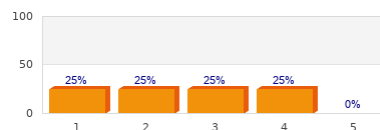

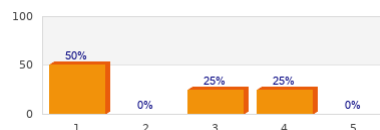

Very Unlikely

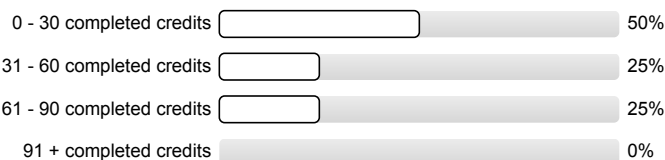

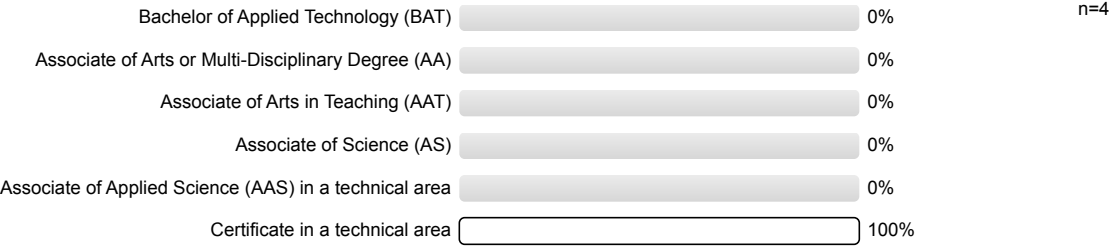

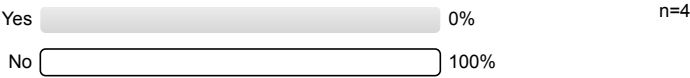
