- 1. Use collaboration in the creation of theatrical productions.
- 2. Demonstrate the practical application of appropriately leveled theatrical skills and procedures. procedures.
- 3. Apply critical thinking skills required for the creation of a theatrical production.

As this is a practical laboratory course, requirements will vary between students and will be discussed in class.

Attendance

Special emphasis is laid upon 100% of the work notated above. Each production involves significant investments in terms of money, time, and effort, with countless individuals purchasing tickets and eagerly anticipating their theater experience. Each member of our class plays a vital role in ensuring the success of our season's performances. It's crucial that we all demonstrate dedication and show up consistently, as any lack of commitment would inevitably diminish the quality of our shows, harm the reputation of Brazosport College, and result in immediate failure of the class. Let's work together to guarantee our collective success and avoid any setbacks.

As your work in this class is vital to the public facing productions and reputation of Brazosport College (see above), absences from rehearsal or performances are not permitted and will result in failure of the class. A single unexcused absence will result in your failure of the class. Three tardies equals one absence. Being later than 10 minutes after your assigned start time will count as an absence.

Excusable absences are left to the discretion of the instructor. I know things happen, people get sick, cars break down... You must notify the stage manager or the instructor before you're your call time if it is unavoidable that you will be late or absent.
